RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested and has considered said request to support the 1976-77 Miss White Mountain Apache in a trip to Baltimore, Maryland for the purposes of representing the White Mountain Apache Tribe at a conference entitled "I Am An American", and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires the Tribe to be represented at the meeting as described to it in the request; and
- WHEREAS, the total cost for said trip shall be \$920.50 and the Tribal Council agrees to provide one-half of said cost to the Tribal Queen Committee for the purposes of the trip.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby grants to the Tribal Queen Committee the sum of \$460.25, said amount to be paid from the tribal public relations (internal) funds.

The foregoing resolution was on September 22, 1976, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
