## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- Whereas, the White Mountain Apache Tribe owns and operates the Whiteriver Commercial Center, a Tribal Enterprise; and
- Whereas, The Board of Directors of the Whiteriver Commercial Center, in accordance with the Plan of Operation of the Enterprise, has submitted and recommends for approval by the Tribal Council a general and operating budget for the Whiteriver Commercial Center for the Fiscal year ending April 30, 1977 and
- Whereas, the Plan of Operation of the Whiteriver Commerical Center was approved on September 22, 1976.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
  Tribe that the budget for operating expenses in the amount
  of \$198,616.00 and cost of sales in the amount of \$648,581.00
  is hereby approved for the operation of the Whiteriver
  Commercial Center for the remainder of the Fiscal Year
  beginning May 1, 1976 and ending April 30, 1977.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this budget may be increased proportionately in cost of sales and operating expense if Income exceeds \$856,240.00.

The foregoing resolution was on October 15, 1976, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
