RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Phillip Stago, Sr. has been granted a lease for a business, and

WHEREAS, business to be located on 1.25 acres on the Northwest corner of the Whiteriver Commercial Center area, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires more of its members go into business.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that
Phillip Stago, Sr. be granted a business lease on 1.25 acres of land
for a term of twenty-five (25) years with an option to renew for twentyfive (25) years. Copy of the description to be on file in the Superindent's Office, Fort Apache Agency, Whiteriver, Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent and the Tribal Chairman be authorized and directed to consumate a lease for the described property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 76-42 be rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on November 3, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
