## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Whiteriver School District No. 20 has applied for a P.L. 815 Grant for the new High School, and
- WHEREAS, the Whiteriver School District was notified on September 17, 1976, that funds will be available under P. L. 93-638, and
- WHEREAS, under P. L. 93-638, Part 277, there is authority for the Local School Board to contract for public school construction, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council strongly supports the endeavors of the Local School Board of School District No. 20 to contract under the authority of P.L. 93-638 for a new high school plant.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that it is in full support of School Board of School District No. 20 contracting under the authority of P. L. 93-638 for a new high school.

The foregoing resolution was on November 3, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
