

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the recommendations of the Director of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise to extend the Bear Hunting Season from November 8 through December 31, 1976, and


WHEREAS, this extension of the Bear Hunting Season serves the general welfare of the Tribe and of the Enterprise.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the extension of the 1976 Bear Hunting Season to December 31, 1976, beginning on November 8, 1976.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the extended hunt herein directed shall be a guided hunt only, with tribal guides.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the authorization contained in this resolution shall be contingent upon the approval of the Board of Directors of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise.

The foregoing resolution was on November 3, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
