RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has requested that the White Mountain Apache Utility Authority relocate the water main on upper Cibecue, road right-of-way, and
- WHEREAS, the Public Health Service contracted with the White Mountain Apache Utility Authority to install this line six months ago, and
- WHEREAS, the Water System belongs to the White Mountain Apache Utility Authority and they maintain this system, and it should be constructed to meet their specifications, and
- WHEREAS, the upper Cibecue road cannot be completed until this work is done.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that permission be given to the White Mountain Apache Utility Authority to do this work. Project estimate is \$9,000.00.

The foregoing resolution was on November 3, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
