## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been contracting for the Housing Improvement Program under the old agreements, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to continue contracting for the Housing Improvement Program under the authority of P.L. 93-638, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Housing Improvement Program is to upgrade and make more livable Indian homes of individuals who qualify.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a P.L. 93-638 contract for the Housing Improvement Program in the amount of \$60,000.00 be granted.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to negotiate a contract and any amendments thereof and also authorized to execute the contract and any amendments.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of the contract and authority granted will be from October 1, 1976 to September 30, 1977.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a review be made before the Tribal Council at ninety-day intervals for the purpose of observing progress and application of methods to the project.

The foregoing resolution was on November 3, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
