RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has granted right-of-ways for the Geronimo Cave-Rock Creek Road, and
- WHEREAS, the Turkey Creek Livestock Association do not want the area fenced.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that no new fence be constructed from Geronimo Cave on the Rock Creek Road.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Turkey Creek Livestock Association has requested the Tribal Council to direct the Bureau of Indian Affairs to not build this fence because of lack of adequate water facilities and it would inhibit the free movement of range cattle.

The foregoing resolution was on November 22, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
