RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, one of the requirements for the planning of distribution of 22-D requires a thirty-day posting, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires that the posting take place immediately, and
- WHEREAS, this posting is to be on November 22, 1976 through December 22, 1976.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that to be in compliance with the requirements for the settlement of 22-D, that on November 22, 1976, a posting be made of all names of tribal members and Social Security Numbers in alphabetical order and the designated locations of these postings shall be:

Tribal Office, Receptionist's Desk Bureau of Indian Affairs Office, Hallway Bulletin Board Cibecue Community Center

These postings are to remain in place for a period of thirty (30) days which will end at midnight, December 22, 1976.

- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each individual tribal member may contact a designated person at each posting location to confirm all pertinent information listed on the official tribal roll.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that at the direction of the Tribal Council for individual inspection of all pertinent information on the tribal roll, can only be done for self or immediate family members.

The foregoing resolution was on November 22, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
