RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is determined in developing its own natural resources, particularly that of its young people, through human and development of social services programs for them, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Community Action Agency plans to sponsor a State-wide Indian Youth Conference, and
- WHEREAS, the conference will be designed to bring together, for the first time, young Indian people from various reservations to discuss Indian youth concerns, education, recreation, personal growth, employment, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Community Action Agency shall search for Federal, State and other sources of funding for this proposed project; and further plans to attend Tribal Council meetings in Arizona for their input, support and commitment.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby endorses and encourages the Indian Youth Conference Project of the White Mountain Apache Community Action Agency.

The foregoing resolution was on December 1, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
