

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the council discussed the need for additional housing at Fort Apache Junction, and

WHEREAS, these homesites are on the south side of the highway west of Fort Apache Junction, and

WHEREAS, the council desires that all sewage plants and domestic water be increased for the Fort Apache Junction area to facilitate additional homesites.

BE IT RESOLVED United States Indian Health Service expand and construct adequate sewage system for the area and improve the water system to where it is adequate for future expansion plus the addition of fire protection for the community.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that United States Public Health Service start immediately on the planning and include this project in Fiscal Year, 1977 construction plan.

The foregoing resolution was on December 2, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
