RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council to improve the housing situation on the reservation, and
- WHEREAS, for this purpose, the Tribal Council desires to enter into a long-term lease with the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority, and
- WHEREAS, this lease will cover the ninety (90) units in Housing Project 16-14, 15, 16, 18, 21,22 and 23.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and the Superintendent are directed to enter into a lease with the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority for those areas covered under Housing Project 16-14, 15, 16, 18, 21, 22 and 23.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority submit to the Superintendent's Office, each description and survey of the ninety (90) units in Housing Project 16-14, 15, 16, 18, 21, 22 and 23.

The foregoing resolution was on December 2, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
