RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Culture Center has drafted 'The Origin of the Apache Crown Dancers" in written form; and
- WHEREAS, the story therein contained is part of the tradition and culture of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires that the legal rights and interests of the Tribe in said written story be protected.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe Tribe that the written form of "The Orgin of the Apache Crown Dancers" be copyrighted.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is authorized to sign any and all documents as are necessary to carry out the purpose of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on January 5, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section1(g) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
