RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Education Department receives funding through the Johnson O'Malley Act; and
- WHEREAS, through such funding the Education Department leases a 1977 Ford L.T.D. Station Wagon for use in the Education program; and
- WHEREAS, said leasing is required by federal law, and costs the Education Department \$350 per month for the vehicle with a retail purchase price of \$5,779.40 plus tax and license; and
- WHEREAS, the Education Department proposes that the Tribe buy said vehicle, and lease it to the Education Department in order that the leasing fees remain within the Tribe and that the Department can save money on the rental in excess of the retail price of the vehicle; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds the proposal to be in the best interests of the Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it authorizes the Tribal Business Office to purchase the 1977 Ford L.T.D. Station Wagon presently being leased by the Education Department from Hall Motors, Inc. in Show Low, Arizona, and to thereafter lease said vehicle to the Education Department at the rate of \$350 per month until the full purchase price has been re-paid to the Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council authorizes said expenditure from the contingency fund of the Central Tribe's FY 1976-77 Budget.
- The foregoing resolution was on January 5, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
