RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Resolution 76-175 and 76-176 were passed by the Tribal Council in the November Council meeting; and
- WHEREAS, Resolution 76-175 and 76-176 were not received in the Agency Office within the ten (10) day limit as specified in the Constitution and By-Laws;
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Resolutions 76-175 and 76-176 are reaffirmed and are to be re-transmitted to the Agency Office as required in the By-Laws and Constitution.

The foregoing resolution was on January 5, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
