RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has constructed a Commercial Enterprise in Whiteriver, "The Whiteriver Commerical Center", with rental spaces for the establishment of individual tribal member businesses; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Directors for the Whiteriver Commercial Center has accepted and reviewed various applications for store space rental from individual tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, said Board of Directors has recommended three such applications to the Tribal Council for certification of intent to lease space to such applicants; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the applications of Mr. Adam Lupe, Sr., and Charlene Lupe, his wife; Mrs. Lavinia Minjarez; and Mr. Kay A. Lewis, and finds said applications satisfactory.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby certifies its intent to lease to Mr. Adam Lupe, Sr., and Charlene J. Lupe, his wife; to Mrs. Lavinia Minjarez; and to Mr. Kay A. Lewis, upon such terms and conditions as shall be negotiated by and between the Tribal Council and said individual Tribal members at the time financing of the proposed businesses of each has been arranged.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
