## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise has requested permission to issue cross country ski permits; and
- WHEREAS, as it is the responsibility of the Enterprise to police and patrol the area for the reserve involved.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Recreation Enterprise issue permits for cross country skiing.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the area designated starts at the Ryan Ranch Road (ditch camp) and proceeds down stream from that point to McCoys bridge, a total distance of approximately five (5) miles. The area's that will be open to skiing is the immediate drainage area of the North Fork of the Whiteriver between these two (2) points.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Recreation Enterprise has the responsibility of marking and identifying these use areas.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
