RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Enterprises operates a commercial store facility in the Cibecue Community which is open for business in excess of eight hours per day; and
- WHEREAS, the United States Postal Service operates a postal facility in the Cibecue Community located at a commercial store operated by a licensed trader; and
- WHEREAS, complaints have been received from residents of the Community regarding the service received from the current operations of the Postal facility; and
- WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Tribal Council that the operation of a postal facility within the commercial store owned by the White Mountain Apache Enterprises would provide better service to the residents of Cibecue.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council be instructed and authorized to negotiate with the United States Postal Service to transfer postal facilities to the Tribal store and to sign any and all documents necessary to effectuate this.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
