RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to contract with the State of Arizona Department of Economic Security for Work Experience and Manpower Services under Title I of the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has successfully contracted for such a program in previous years providing numerous jobs and training for Tribal members.
- BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Chairman be instructed to and authorized to enter into and sign all necessary documents to effectuate a contract with the Arizona Department of Economic Security for a work experience and manpower program under Title I of the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act.

The foregoing resolution was on January 11, 1977duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
