## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe authorizes operation of HUD Mutual Help Housing Program on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, individual tribal members purchase such mutual help houses through this program, and
- WHEREAS, said individual tribal member purchasers often request information from the Tribe concerning the balances due on their loans to purchase these houses, and the original costs, interest and any other monetary terms and conditions, and
- WHEREAS, none of this information has been made available by HUD to the Tribe, or the Tribal Housing Authority, for the purpose of advising the individual tribal member purchasers of the financial details of their respective loans.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe respectfully requests that HUD provide to the Tribe, or the Tribal Housing Authority, all information concerning the monetary terms and conditions, costs and amounts due on individual tribal members' Mutual Help Housing loans.

The foregoing resolution was on February 2, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and by-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
