RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, White Mountain Apache Tribal Council Resolution No. 76-167 states the priorities for the development of new community health care programs requested for funding through the Phoenix Area Indian Health Service, and
- WHEREAS, new Federal regulations under PL 93-638 granting authority have required that three of the projects listed in the original resolution be revised significantly, and
- WHEREAS, the Phoenix Area Indian Health Service requires official authorization to consider the revised project proposals for immediate funding.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the list of program priorities in the original Council resolution be amended to read as follows:
