

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe reviewed and accepted the proposal of the Chaghache Day Care Center Board of Directors, a copy of which is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is deeply concerned with the health, welfare and safety of Apache children.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs and authorizes that the Central Tribe Finance Committee review the Central Tribal Budget and select therefrom available funding for a six-foot chain link fence to surround the Chaghache Day Care Center premises.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Business Office is authorized to expend such funds from the Central Tribal Budget as are selected by the Finance Committee for the purposes of this resolution.


The foregoing resolution was on March 9, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

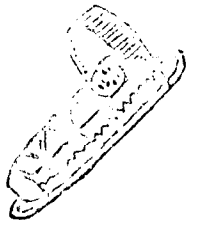

Proposed Resolution

WHEREAS, a precious investment in the future of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is with the care and well being of children at the Chaghache Day Care Center.

WHEREAS, the Day care center is located near a busy highway with heavy traffic which presents a continuous danger of accidents to small children.

WHEREAS, incidents of trespassing involving intoxicated persons, vandalism and general malicious behavior have caused a great deal of concern on the part of Indian parents.

WHEREAS, the Day Care Center does not have the funds to provide for a fence around the immediate area of the Day Care Center.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe will provide sufficient tribal funds for the construction of a six foot chain link fence for the protection and welfare of children at the Chaghache Day Care Center.
