WHEREAS,Mrs. Velva Mae (Burnette) Tessay requested that she be assigned Tribal Police Quarters No. T-85, located at Canyon Day, Gila County, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, said quarters are owned by the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Tribal Police Quarters No. T-85, located at Canyon Day, Gila County, Arizona be assigned to Mrs. Velva Mae (Burnette) Tessay for use as living quarters, with the understanding that all maintenance and repairs are her responsibility.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all prior rent delinquencies owed by Mrs. Tessay to the Tribe, are hereby waived.

The foregoing resolution was on March 9, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
