## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has Revenue Sharing Savings and Funds presently available, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires that such savings and funds be utilized in the best interests of the reservation communities, and

WHEREAS, the Rainbow City Community is in urgent need of a Community Building which would serve the adults and youths in the community, and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of construction of said Community Building is approximately \$35,000.00.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby directs and authorizes the expenditure of Revenue Sharing Savings and Funds, from those available up to Grant Period eight (8) in the approximate amount of \$35,000.00 for the purpose of providing said funds to the Rainbow City Community for the construction of a Community Building.

The foregoing resolution was on March 21, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 3 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
