RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has discussed and considered the request of the Tribal Vice-Chairman for a new tribal vehicle to replace the present vehicle authorized for the Vice-Chairman's use, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that said vehicle urgently needs replacement for the safety and welfare of the tribal personnel authorized to use it.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby directs and authorizes the Tribal Business Office to purchase a new vehicle to replace that which is presently authorized for use by the Vice-Chairman.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the expenditure of such funds herein authorized shall be made from tribal savings; provided that if no such savings are sufficiently available, then such expenditure shall be authorized by provision therefore in the 1977 78 Central Tribal Budget.

The foregoing resolution was on March 21, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
