## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, P.L. 94-437 authorizes Indian Health Service to provide funds (\$759,000.00) for the construction of the Cibecue Health Facility (Clinic) beginning in October of 1977, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is interested in bidding on construction contracts for the clinic building, and
- WHEREAS, it is in keeping with the development of the Tribal Cibecue Community Center Complex and construction contract bid costs to have the clinic building located adjacent to the community center complex buildings.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council approve the location of the Cibecue Indian Health Service Health Facility (Clinic) on the old Bureau of Indian Affairs school site, adjacent to the proposed Cibecue Community Center Complex, as shown in the attached maps.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Phoenix Area Indian Health Service be instructed to immediately begin necessary planning activities for this construction project.

The foregoing resolution was on April 6, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
