RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that a deceased tribal member, Alexander Ethelbah, is presently buried in Potter's Field at Highland Park Cemetery, Cleveland, Ohio, and
- WHEREAS, the family of such tribal member reside on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and strongly desire that his remains be returned for burial to the Reservation, from where he comes, and where he belongs, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that proper burial of its tribal members on the Reservation is an important cultural and personal interest of the Apache people.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe directs and authorizes that funds be utilized from the Central Tribal Budget Contingency Funds, not to exceed \$1500.00 as and for costs of obtaining the remains of Alexander Ethelbah from the Highland Park Cemetery in Cleveland, Ohio, and transporting same to the Fort Apache Indian Reservation on behalf of the family of such tribal member.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs and authorizes the Tribal Chairman to assist the family of Alexander Ethelbah in making any arrangements necessary to fulfill the purposes of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on April 6, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
