


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been repeatedly and currently advised of innumerable complaints by Apache people regarding the conduct and acts of Mr. Darrell Sumner as an employee of the Fort Apache Timber Company, and
 - WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe owns and operates the Fort Apache Timber Company as a tribal enterprise for the best interests and benefits of all the Apache people, and
 - WHEREAS, the relationships and conduct of non-Indian employees of the Tribe towards the Apache tribal members is of grave concern to the Tribal Council in such beneficial operation of its enterprises for its people.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby strongly recommends and urges that the General Manager of the Fort Apache Timber Company immediately terminate Mr. Darrell Sumner from employment with the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on May 4, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for, 1 abst. for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
