

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the council reviewed the request of the Council Secretary, and

WHEREAS, the Council Secretary, Mrs. Endfield, was unable to utilize some of her annual leave and accumulated compensatory time because of various tribal business, land claims, elections and enrollment duties, and


WHEREAS, the Council agrees that compensation from May 14, 1976 through December 30, 1977 at a total of 95 hours was accumulated and unused, and

WHEREAS, due to the additional accumulated duties and the excessive work for the Tribal Council, that the claim is just and should be paid.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mrs. Mary C. Endfield be compensated for the 95 hours of compensatory time for the total sum of \$447.45.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the \$447.45 be paid from Contingency Account or any other source available.

The foregoing resolution was on May 17, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


