WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe had assigned a welfare house to Abner Kahn, and

WHEREAS, the welfare house is located in the Forestdale area, and


WHEREAS, the house is now vacant due to the death of Abner Kahn, and


WHEREAS, it has been determined that Edgar Kahn has a need for the welfare house.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the welfare house at Forestdale that had been assigned to Abner Kahn be reassigned for the full use by Edgar Kahn, brother of Abner Kahn.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED any transfer or change in assignment will need approval by the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on May 4, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
