RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Office of Native American Programs is currently operating various programs on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, they have encountered problems with their letter of credit draw in the amount of \$20,000.00 for the month of June, and

WHEREAS, these funds will become available during the month of July, and

WHEREAS, the existing programs will be terminated for one month unless temporary funding sources are made available.

BE IT RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$20,000.00 currently on deposit with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be advanced to cover operating expenses for the month of June for the Office of Native American Programs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this advance be immediately repaid upon receipt of the June funds from the Federal Government by the Office of Native American Programs.

The foregoing resolution was on June 1, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
