

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Community at McNary has selected a site for a community ball park north of Pruedhome Hall; and


WHEREAS, there is about 20,000 board feet of timber on this area; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company has declined harvesting this timber due to the foreign material imbedded in the logs and the small volume of timber.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Permit authorization be and is hereby amended to authorize the Bureau of Indian Affairs Branch of Forestry to sell these logs by bid at not less than \$5.00 per thousand board feet gross scale to the highest bidders on the open market.

The foregoing resolution was on July 6, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
