WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation has tentatively scheduled the widening and overlay of State Route 73, Mile Post 331 to Amos Wash, Project No. S-215-508; and


WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation is requesting permission to work on the channels outside of their existing right-of-way to channel upstream and downstream.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and the Superintendent are hereby authorized and directed to grant permission to the Arizona Department of Transportation to work on said channels.

The foregoing resolution was on July 6, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
