

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is aware that lighting is needed for the Whiteriver Ballpark; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that it is in the best interests of the community that such needed lighting be installed, from such funds as are available.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes the expenditure of \$6,051.75 for the installation of lighting at the Whiteriver Ball Park from available Revenue Sharing funds if no other tribal funds are available.

The foregoing resolution was on July 6, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
