RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe are in need of housing, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to apply to Housing and Urban Development for additional housing units, and
- WHEREAS, it is requested by the Tribal Council that a new project be approved for 150 Mutual-Help Units.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman be authorized and directed to apply for 150 Mutual-Help Housing Units from Housing and Urban Development.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Housing and Urban Development consider this request as a very high priority of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and do everything they can to expedite the project.

The foregoing resolution was on July 12, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
