WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has considered the dire need for housing for the elderly, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is very sincere about the care of their elders, and


WHEREAS, the immediate need is for a unit of 50.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman be authorized and directed to apply to Housing and Urban Development for 50 Elderly Units.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to sign any and all documents required to consummate the project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Housing and Urban Development consider this request a very high priority of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on July 12, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
