RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council discussed the need for a new Tribal Work Experience hauling truck, and;
- WHEREAS, this new truck is to replace an undependable used by Tribal Work Experience Program, and;
- WHEREAS, in the Tribal Work Experience contract, the Tribe is obligated to furnish safe and dependable equipment.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman be authorized and directed to amend the Tribal Budget for an increase of \$14,000 for the purchase of a new Tribal Work Experience Program truck.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the \$14,000 increase in the current year tribal budget be withdraw funds on deposit with the U.S. Treasurer.

The foregoing resolution was on August 4, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
