## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, additional water supply is required for the town of Whiteriver for domestic consumption and for fire protection purposes; and
- WHEREAS, an easement is needed for the pipeline route, test holes, and well site;
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs is prepared to drill test holes, construct a water well and a pipeline to connect to existing system.
- WHEREAS, the area between the river and orchard and escortment and river from the chlorinator on the south to 1,650 feet up stream an area of 7.25 acres more or less.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Council so grant an easement for a water well field, pipeline, and chlorinators.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attached plot be made a part of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on August 16, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
