WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is presently involved in litigation in the Federal District Court in Phoenix, Arizona entitled, "White Mountain Apache Tribe vs. Arizona Game and Fish Department.", and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires the supporting involvement of the United States Attorney's Office in litigation.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe respectfully requests the United States Attorney's Office, on behalf of the Department of the Interior, to join in the aforementioned litigation in the support of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized and directed to contact the Solicitor's Office and the Office of the Area Director to request the assistance of the U. S. Attorney's Office.

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
