

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Overall Economic Development Program (OEDP) was approved by Tribal Council Resolution No. 77-118 on June 1, 1977, and

WHEREAS, a priority objective of the OEDP (page 1 therein) is to establish an integrated planning function that will coordinate economic planning with general community development, including land use planning and zoning, and

WHEREAS, the development of the technical information necessary to support the numerous priority projects defined in the OEDP requires the use of qualified professional expertise from sources outside the reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Laboratory of Native Development, Systems Analysis and Applied Technology (NADSAT) of the University of Arizona is funded by the Economic Development Administration (EDA) specifically to provide technical assistance to Indian Tribes by applying science and technology to the effective use and economic development of their land, water, energy and human resources.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby requests that the technical resources of the NADSAT program be used to the maximum possible extent (compatible with Tribal objectives as outlined in the Tribal Overall Economic Development Program) to assist the development of the Tribal economic and human resources; and that a comprehensive inventory of reservation land and water resources be addressed as a priority objective.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is authorized and directed to sign any and all necessary documents.

The foregoing resolution was on February 1, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
