

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been funded in the amount of \$35,000.00 by the Four Corners Regional Commission for the purchase of five (5), twelve-passenger vans for routine patient transportation, and
- WHEREAS, these vans will be assigned to Reservation communities (Cibecue, One, (1); Carrizo and Cedar Creek, One, (1); McNary and North Fork, One, (1); Whiteriver/Canyon Day/ East Fork/Seven Mile, Two, (2); to provide regularly scheduled transportation to the Whiteriver Indian Health Service Hospital, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has agreed to provide drivers for these patient vans from the Tribal CETA Program, and
- WHEREAS, the Phoenix Area Indian Health Service has approved the use of Community Health Representative (CHR) Program funds saved from transportation costs for vehicle operating expenses (gas, repairs, etc.) for this new program, and
- WHEREAS, these funds from the CHR Program will not become available until about May 1, 1978 for use in the new Patient Transportation Program.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council approve the use of up to \$2,000.00 for operating expenses (gas, repairs, etc.) for these five (5) patient transportation vehicles until funding becomes available in May of 1978 from the CHR Program.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Health Authority will continue to seek alternate sources of funding for this program so that it may effectively meet the needs of the White Mountain Apache people.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the current operating budget for the Central Tribe be amended to reflect an increase of \$2,000.00 for said vehicle operating expenses from local tribal funds.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized and directed to sign any and all documents necessary to consummate this budget increase from local funds.

The foregoing resolution was on February 2, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
