

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Resolution No. 77-154 adopted on August 3, 1977, approved an assignment of the Elena Baha lease to Jennifer Johnson Nez, and
- WHEREAS, Jennifer Johnson Nez did not assume the Farmers Home Administration loan on this property, and
- WHEREAS, the Farmers Home Administration desires to transfer the Elena Baha lease, Contract No. 14-20-OH52-81, to Leola Mae Cosay Webster, and
- WHEREAS, Leola Mae Cosay Webster desires to assume the Farmers Home Administration loan on the property and has been qualified by the Farmers Home Administration for a rural housing loan.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a lease assignment is hereby approved and that the Chairman of the Tribal Council and the Superintendent of Fort Apache Indian Agency are hereby directed to execute any and all documents necessary to approve the assignment.

The foregoing resolution was on February 1, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
