RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council discussed the problems arising in the Tribal Butane Enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, the Enterprise is attempting to make better deliveries and initiate a system to prevent people from running out of butane gas, and
- WHEREAS, to adequately cover the service area, there is need for an additional truck for delivery, and
- WHEREAS, the best estimate from the advertised bids for the complete unit was approximately \$16,000.00.
- BE IT RESOLVED from the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the expenditures for the additional butane delivery truck be approved and the truck be ordered.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it was the direction of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to place this item in the amount of \$16,000.00 on the new operating budget for the 1978-1979 Tribal Operating year.

The foregoing resolution was on March 1, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
