

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Torrii Landscape & Sprinkler Co, Inc., has a contract to landscape the new U. S. Public Health Hospital, and


WHEREAS, their request for one hundred (100) mature pine and juniper trees had been discussed in the Forestry Committee, and

WHEREAS, the Forestry Committee recommends that these transplants be sold to Torrii Company at One Dollar (\$1.00) for the trees up to eight (8) feet tall and twenty-five cents (.25) per foot for each foot over eight feet in height.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the permit authorization for Fiscal Year, 1978 be amended to allow a permit to be issued to Torrii Landscape and Sprinkler Company, Inc. at the rates recommended by the Forestry Committee for trees transplanted at the new hospital.

The foregoing resolution was on March 1, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
