



RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Councilman Lynn Cody from the Cedar Creek-Carrizo-Forestdale District successfully ran for the Office of Vice-Chairman and is seated in that position, and
- WHEREAS, the term of his previous position on the council does not expire until April, 1980, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is empowered by the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to fill any vacancies on the Council, by appointments, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the wishes and best interests of the tribal members in filling the vacated council position to provide representation for the Cedar Creek-Carrizo-Forestdale District.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby declares vacant, the Council position for the Cedar Creek-Carrizo-Forestdale District previously occupied by Mr. Cody.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Raymus Albert is hereby appointed to fill this vacancy for the unexpired term thereof, and to fully serve as the district representative for the Cedar Creek-Carrizo-Forestdale District on the Tribal Council until April, 1980 or such time thereafter as a successor is duly selected.

The foregoing resolution was on May 10, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
