

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs obtained use on approximately 1½ acres of tribal land adjacent to the McNary Forestry Station for containerized greenhouses, and

WHEREAS, there is a necessity to expand this operation thus there is a need for another approximately two acres south of the existing facility, and

WHEREAS, this has been discussed with the livestock association involved (Cedar Creek) and they have no objection.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs may utilize approximately two (2) acres (300' x 300') and south of the existing facility.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Pulpwood Enterprise may, if they wish, have any pulpwood off of this area stumpage free.


The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
