

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the cutting expiration date on the following described logging unit expired on December 31, 1977:

<u>UNIT</u>	<u>CONTRACT NUMBER</u>
Soldier Butte	H50C-1420-6956

and

WHEREAS, this logging unit is under contract to the Fort Apache Timber Company, and

WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company has requested that the contract date be extended to permit them enough time to harvest the remaining timber that should be logged, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tribe to extend this date to allow the Fort Apache Timber Company to finish cutting and perform other contract obligations.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe consents to extend the cutting expiration date and the contract expiration date for other sale obligations on the Soldier Butte Logging Unit as follows:


