FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Health, Education and Welfare Committee requested from the Council support on a youth work education proposal, and

WHEREAS, this proposal would hire vocational instructors and supervision for unemployed youth during the summer, and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the proposed program was \$13,901.00.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the education budget for the Tribal Fiscal Year 1978-79 included \$10,301. for the operation of the program and an amount of \$3,000.00 for the miscellaneous tools, hammers, saws, etc. for a total of \$13,901.00.


The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
