

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe, through the White Mountain Housing Authority, carries out its responsibility for improving the housing conditions of its people, and

WHEREAS, in the process of developing and building the various HUD housing projects over the years, unspent housing development funds have been accumulated in the sum of \$217,026.52, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development has approved the use of these funds for the rehabilitation and modernization of 225 existing HUD low-cost housing units, to include insulation, re-painting, floors and/or floor supports, and fireplaces.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council hereby approves the rehabilitation and modernization program as outlined herein and directs the White Mountain Housing Authority to take the necessary actions to implement the program to the extent of available funds.


The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
