

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been invited by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to submit a pre-application for a grant to fund the following Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) activities:

- (1) Building of fireplaces in seventy (70) existing HUD low-cost housing units on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation--estimated cost, \$70,000.
- (2) Building of an industrial park adjacent to the Fort Apache Timber Company--up to \$200,000.
- (3) Developing a comprehensive planning program to promote economic and social development on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation--\$65,000.
- (4) Construction/surfacing/draining of ski area access road and parking area at Sunrise Park Recreation Enterprise--\$315,000. or
- (5) Construction of a manpower training center to prepare unemployed Tribal members for permanent jobs and to upgrade employed Tribal members for advancement and promotion--up to \$315,000.00, and


WHEREAS, the Overall Economic Development Program Committee, by Resolution of April 13, 1978, (attached) has endorsed the said projects and recommended Tribal Council approval, and

WHEREAS, in connection with such pre-application the White Mountain Apache Tribe is asked to resolve and make certain assurances.

BE IT RESOLVED that:

- (1) The White Mountain Apache Tribal Council does hereby affirm that it is the duly constituted representative body for all the people of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
- (2) The Tribal Council, in open and public session, hereby provides the opportunity for Tribal citizens to articulate needs, to express preferences about proposed community development, and to assist in the selection of priorities.
- (3) The Tribal Council does hereby approve the proposed projects as detailed herein and authorizes the Tribal Chairman to submit to HUD such documents as are necessary to obtain the grant funds required to finance those projects, and to take such other actions as are necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.


The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
